Reopening timeline:

December 14: Comprehensive Reopening Staffing Model Spreadsheet shared with principals.
Preliminary report for Lincoln (68 teaching and non-teaching staff members):

- o 21 – will return

- o 18 – no response (CPS sees these as “assumed will return”)

- o 14 – applied for non-ADA accommodation

- o 15 – applied for ADA accommodation December 15: CPS presented informational webinar “Principal Reopening Updates: Staffing, Scheduling and Coverage” December 17: CPS will present informational webinar “Principal Reopening Updates: Health Protocols and ITS Updates”

902 students enrolled at Lincoln. 899 Lincoln students have a response of either ‘hybrid learning’ or “learn at home”. 72% of the 899 Lincoln students have a response of “hybrid learning”

Lincoln will receive the following positions paid for by central office:

- o Two cadre substitute teachers

- o 4 misc. employees

December 21: CPS will release a Reopening Instructional Guidance document for all educators to support teachers with instructional and curricular planning to meet the needs of students at home and at school

January 4: Notifications begin regarding decisions for K-8 staff accommodation requests

January 11: Complete notifications regarding determinations for accommodation/leave shared with K-8 staff (through January 15)

January 18: Finalize K-8 teaching assignments

January 18: Schools share teaching assignments and initial rosters with teachers in grades K-8

January 18: Share homeroom assignments and in-person instruction days with K-8 parents

January 25: K-8 staff return

January 29: K-8 teachers share with families: an introductory letter, overview of student daily schedules, and communication plan for in-person and remote students

February 1: K-8 students return
